DAY 3

Monday, April 16 - **AMALFI - VIETRI- RAVELLO**

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Excursion by private minibus and guide along the spectacular Amalfi Coast, one of Europe's most beautiful shorelines, with views of lush gardens and olive-green slopes, hovering over the clear sea below. Experience the warmth of the gentle and friendly locals. Explore Amalfi with its beautiful cathedral, Vietri Sul Mare, one of the 13 pearls of the Amalfi Coast famous around the world for the lively ceramic handicrafts which date back to the XV century. And then to Ravello to enjoy one of the most beautiful views of the coast.

DAY 5

Wednesday, April 18 - **CAPRI**

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Morning hydrofoil ride from Positano to Capri (*tickets not included. Must be purchased locally*). Your private guide will meet you at the port of Capri where you will take a private boat (a traditional Caprese Gozzo) to circumnavigate the island and have a chance to view the famous grottoes - the Blue Grotto, (*entrance is contingent upon prevailing tides and therefore the entrance fees are not included*), the White Grotto and the Faraglioni Rock Formations.

Then take the funicular from Marina Grande up to Capri and walk to the Gardens of Caesar Augustus or the Punta Tragara. Other alternatives include the following:



Capri - Villa San Michele

a challenging walk to the Villa Jovis to visit the ruins of Tiberius' most important imperial villa; a visit to Villa San Michele with its beautiful gardens and museum; or a ride on the chair lift to the highest point of the island. Private taxi service is included for those who prefer not to walk. There will be time for lunch (not included) and for relaxing in Capri's famous main square. Return to the port by private taxi. Tour includes guide, private boat tour, funicular tickets, taxi transportation as noted and either entry fees to Villa San Michele or the chair lift to Mount Solaro.

DAY 6

Thursday, April 19 - **HERCULANEUM - CASERTA**

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Today your private excursion will take you to the northern side of the peninsula to Herculaneum, the amazingly preserved ancient Roman city destroyed by the pyroclastic flows AD 79. During your guided tour you will see the best preserved structures of all the other cities destroyed by the volcanic eruption and will give you a much better idea of what Roman town looked like.

You will then continue to Caserta, once the residence of the Bourbon kings. Explore the magnificent Royal Palace (the Versailles of Italy) and its gardens designated as a UNESCO World Heritage and the largest of all buildings erected in Europe during the 18th century.
